
WEBSITE ACCESSIBILITY STANDARDS

Here at the dental society office, we know of at least one building in Ventura that has been targeted for lawsuits by someone saying the doctors' websites aren't compatible with the American with Disabilities Act. Please read the article below from CDA regarding these. As a start, be sure to add a link on your website that says to contact the office if someone needs help with the website. Be sure there is someone in the office that knows what's on the website and can help give information. If you have any videos with sound, make sure you have captions!

Website Accessibility Complaints regarding website accessibility are becoming more common. There are a few steps that dental practices with websites can take to decrease the risk of a monetary demand or lawsuit. One strategy is to add an accessibility link to your website. This is language that tells individuals with disabilities how to seek help if they are unable to access something on your practice's website. The language can instruct individuals to phone the office to have staff read content, provide transcripts of videos or assist them with filling out online forms. It is important to train staff on the language in the link and how to appropriately respond to inquiries.

Another approach is to contact your website designer and ask if your website is accessible, and if not, how they can make it accessible. The AwDA standards for website design are known as WCAG 2.0, levels A and AA. You'll want to be sure that your designer can speak to those standards. If you know your website is not accessible, you can take it down temporarily and replace it with a compliant site. Engage a qualified website designer who is familiar with the accessibility standards, and be sure to address compliance with the accessibility standards contractually.

If your practice hired a certified access specialist to inspect your premises that inspection did not necessarily include testing website accessibility. It might be a good idea to check the inspection report. If you're considering hiring an access specialist, you should inquire whether the individual or firm will test your website for accessibility compliance. The American Dental Association has specific guidance for dental practices on website accessibility and how to appropriately defend yourself against potential complaints and lawsuits. The document "Website Accessibility Claims: Strategies for Dentists," a sample accessibility statement, and a list of technology consultants can be found on www.ada.org.



DENTISTS "MUST BE PRUDENT" IN PROTECTING PATIENTS FROM HARMFUL PRODUCTS.

That was the overall message American Dental Association President Chad P. Gehani imparted following the Dec. 16 announcement that the Association has adopted a new interim policy on vaping. The interim policy calls for a total ban on all vaping products that aren't approved by the Food and Drug Administration for tobacco cessation purposes.

The policy, which is in step with the American Medical Association's new policies on vaping, states that the ADA will:

Urgently advocate for regulatory, legislative, and/ or legal action at the federal and/or state levels to ban the sale and distribution of all e-cigarette and vaping products, with the exception of those approved by the FDA for tobacco cessation purposes and made available by prescription only;

and

Advocate for research funding to study the safety and effectiveness of e-cigarettes and vaping products for tobacco cessation purposes and their effects on the oral cavity.

"While the long-term oral health effects of vaping are under scientific review, as health professionals we must be prudent in protecting consumers from potentially harmful products," said Dr. Gehani in an ADA statement. "We will continue to advocate for additional research,

but we must protect the health of our patients first and foremost. A ban such as this would ensure patient safety while allowing us to explore the impact of vaping products on oral health."

The ADA has long advocated for the development of a body of scientific research examining the oral effects of both tobacco and non-tobacco nicotine delivery products as part of the ADA policy on tobacco use.

In addition to this interim policy, in September, the ADA House of Delegates passed a resolution stipulating that the word "vaping" and any other alternative nicotine delivery systems be added to the existing ADA policy focused on tobacco use prevention, research and regulation. The interim policy expands upon the Association's 2016 tobacco policy, which calls for vaping devices to be regulated in the same manner as tobacco products.

Besides the AMA, several other organizations have created resources related to helping health care providers and patients learn more about vaping, including the American Academy of Pediatrics and the American Lung Association. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention also has resources on lung injury and electronic cigarettes and vaping. The ADA encourages dentists and other health care providers to report potential vaping-associated respiratory illness by using the Food and Drug Administration's safety reporting portal.


